



CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Your entry into either The Guzzler 100km or the Glass Half Full 50km (the “Event”) will confirm your full understanding and acceptance of these Conditions of Entry (“Conditions”). Failure to adhere to any of the Conditions may result in immediate disqualification without refund.

1. You are not required to demonstrate any previous experience with trail and/or ultramarathon running in order to enter the Event. It is your responsibility to ensure that, on race day, you are sufficiently fit and healthy to complete the Event within the official cut-off times.
2. The Organisers reserve the right to change the official cut-off times at any stage prior to or during the event in the interest of participant safety or for any other reason.
3. You must be at least 18 years of age on race day to participate in the Event.
4. You understand that the course is technical, remote and physically demanding and that emergency medical aid may be slow to reach you. This constitutes a high risk of serious injury, or possibly death, if an emergency situation occurs while on course.
5. Both before starting and during the Event, you must monitor your own health and well-being and withdraw in the event that you are no longer fit enough to continue safely.
6. You are responsible for the behaviour of your support crew and supporters. It is your responsibility to ensure they fully read and understand any available supporter information and that they do not, knowingly or otherwise, break any rules, breach the Code of Conduct or bring the Event or the Organisers into disrepute.
7. Before registering, you will be required to read and agree to a Release Waiver. A copy of this waiver can be viewed on the Event website.
8. Prior to the start of the event, all participants will be expected to fully read and understand all available and supplied Participant Information including the Code of Conduct. Failure to abide by the Code of Conduct may result in disqualification from the Event and potentially from future Events. Ignorance of the rules and responsibilities laid out in the Rules, Code of Conduct, the Conditions of Entry and the Participant Waiver will not be accepted as a defence.

Insurance

The organiser of the Event, The Trail Co., has public liability insurance cover. This does not include personal accident insurance for competitors. We recommend that you arrange your own personal accident insurance, ambulance cover and income protection insurance before participating in the Event to cover any unforeseen personal costs you may incur due to ambulance trips, medical expenses or time off work due to injuries sustained whilst participating in the Event.

Refunds & Transfers

In the unfortunate instance that you can no longer participate in the event, refunds or transfers may be possible, in line with the policies that are detailed on our website.

Please note, the Organisers reserve the right to re-route, reschedule or cancel the Event at any time, if it is deemed unsafe for any reason or at the direction of the land managers or any other relevant authority. If the event is cancelled, re-routed or shortened, the Organisers will attempt to provide some compensation to entrants, however there are no guarantees as to the extent of this compensation due to costs already incurred prior to cancellation. No responsibility is assumed or taken by the organisers for lost travel or accommodation expenses, or for part or full loss of entry fees paid.
